What is planned within the 2016/17 budget?

The Parish Council has included in its budget for the following items:

- In association with JSPC, providing computer availability at the Centre including for assisted disabled users.
- Having grants to support Sompting for start-up events and organisations needing that "extra" help.
- 3. Increased funds for park improvements with Adur District Council.
- 4. Improved communication between residents and Council.
- 5. Continuing the funding of the 7A bus service.
- 6. Continuing events to bring the community together.
- 7. Conserving Somptings' rural heritage by safeguarding the historic flint walls, and the WW2 air raid shelter at the Centre.

UPDATE ON NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

The Neighbourhood Plan is now reaching its final stage! The Housing and Estate Design Guide is completed and can be viewed on the Council's web site. The Plan will be approved by Full Council in January and forwarded to Adur District Council, the Local Planning Authority for approval. It will then be sent to the Planning Inspector for confirmation that the document can be used for the referendum. A referendum is required so that Sompting residents can "vote" acceptance of the document.
