#### The Council's 2017/18 budget.

Your Parish Council has formed strong working partnerships with Sompting Estate, South Downs National Park Authority and Sussex Sustainable Community to improve the community's access and enjoyment of the South Downs and the environment of certain areas in Sompting. To achieve this, the Council has £ 10,000 in its 2017/18 budget. It also has £4,000.00 to fund resident surveys on various topics throughout the year, giving its community the opportunity to inform the Council "what they think!"



For your information, the 2017/18 expenditure budget is £126,026 with an expected income of £98,265 and use of its reserves at £27,761.
